

Network Services Price Schedule

Effective from 1 October 2016

GasNet is required by law to disclose details of the prices that apply to transport natural gas through its gas distribution network to consumers connected to these networks. GasNet does not charge consumers directly but instead charges the energy retailer who in turn will pass these costs through to the consumer.

The charges that energy retailers pay GasNet are calculated by multiplying the number of days a consumer is connected to GasNet's network by the daily fixed charge from the schedule below, then adding to that the amount of gas the consumer has used multiplied by the variable charge.
